Two urgent reasons to view your credit report

Credit report errors are very common (70% of reports contain errors). Identity fraud is also common, with millions of victims each year. Errors and fraud can destroy your credit. Your credit can affect your ability to get a job, insurance coverage and loans. It can also affect your insurance rates, and credit card and loan interest rates.

The U.S. Secret Service suggests consumers get a copy of their credit report at least once per year. CCOA can help with a Credit Report Review. Meet with a credit professional who can explain your credit report to you, give you a copy of your report and your score, and tell you how to dispute any errors or fraud.
